This workshop will provide an overview of a social skills instructional model recently developed by Dr. Bellini at the Indiana Resource Center for Autism. This session will provide the participant with conceptual information on social functioning, as well as practical strategies for implementing a social skills program. The session will begin by providing relevant information on the social-emotional characteristics of children and adolescents with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD). A five-step model of social skills instruction will be presented which provides the framework and rationale for the selection and delivery of intervention strategies. Participants will be given strategies for identifying and analyzing typical social skill deficits in students with ASD. Participants will also be provided information on the use of effective social skills strategies for individuals with ASD.

Scott Bellini is the Assistant Director of the Indiana Resource Center for Autism (IRCA) at Indiana University, Bloomington. He is also a licensed psychologist working in private practice where he develops and delivers social, emotional, and behavioral interventions for children and adolescents with ASD.
