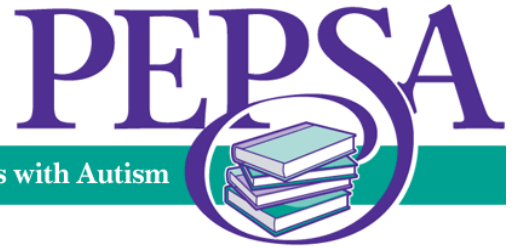

He facilitates the Broward County Asperger’ Support Groups for family members as well as the Teen Time Social Group for individuals with HFA and Asperger’s Syndrome. Brian has served in a variety of professional roles including Clinical Coordinator of the Therapeutic Intervention Program, Tier Leader, and classroom teacher in preschool and elementary school programs for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders. Mr. Roselione has presented nationally and internationally on Applied Behavior Analysis in school settings, communication and social skills, and educational interventions for students with Autism Spectrum Disorders.

From the North: Take 95 south to St. Lucie West exit (#121) go east- to first traffic light (Peacock) make a left- go to third traffic light (University Blvd) make a right- just passed the stadium is FAU- turn left go through the round about and park in the first parking lot on your left- that building is MP- the event is in MP 105/106

From the East: take US 1 to Prima Vista go west to Country Club Dr. make a right- take the first street off of the roundabout (California)- make a left a the stop sign (University)- make immediate right into FAU- go through the round about and park in the first parking lot on your left- that building is MP- the event is in MP 105/106
