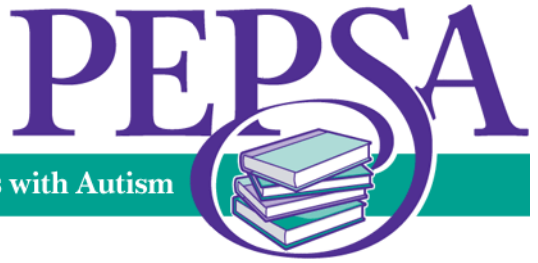

**Training Description**

Students with Asperger’s Syndrome present a unique set of challenges for educators.
