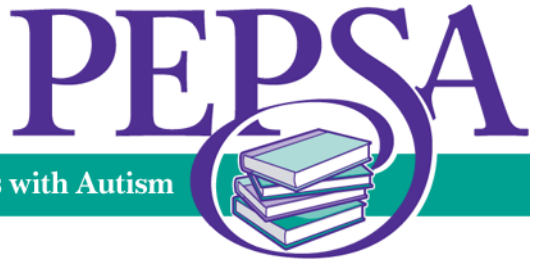

### About the Presenter

Dr. Baker Wright currently works with Behavior Management Consultants, Inc., and he is a Board Certified Behavior Analyst who has been working in the field of Autism and Applied Behavior Analysis for over 10 years. Dr. Wright received his Master's degree in Psychology from East Carolina University, where he specialized in Mental Retardation and Developmental Disorders. He later completed his Ph.D. in ABA at Florida State University. Dr. Wright currently works as a Behavior Consultant to school districts, families, state agencies and residential programs in the panhandle of Florida, Southern Georgia, and Alabama and has been an adjunct professor for Florida State University.

### Training Description

This workshop will detail the diagnostics of Asperger's Disorder/High Functioning Autism and will provide an in-depth look into the behavior supports these individuals require in the classroom, home, and community. This will be done in 2 sections: description and discussion of the diagnostic criteria for Asperger's Disorder and the "3 steps to success" prevention of problem behaviors, management of meltdowns, and positive reinforcement based strategies. This will be a fun and interactive workshop where attendees will participate individually and in small groups in each of the core areas presented.
