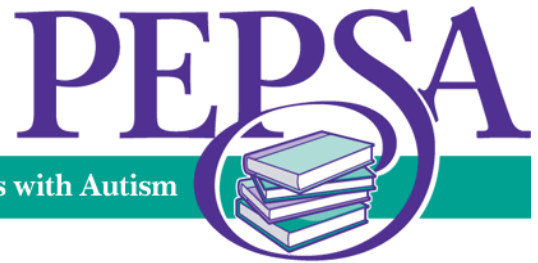

**About the Presenter**

Dr. Teresa Daly is the Director of the Center for Autism and Related Disabilities (CARD) at the University of Central Florida, and has presented nationally and internationally on ASD. She holds a doctorate in psychology with a specialization in developmental disabilities, and is a Board Certified Behavior Analyst who has worked in the ASD field for over 25 years.

**Training Description**

Students with Asperger’s Syndrome present a unique set of challenges for educators. Neurological and research findings will be presented with implications for educational accommodations, and curriculum for addressing social and pragmatic needs will be overviewed. The seminar is appropriate for general and special educators, psychologists, resource teachers, autism support teachers, guidance and administrative personnel as well as parents.

**Training Objectives**

1. Provide an overview of the behavioral and neurological characteristics of Asperger’s Syndrome.
2. Relate these characteristics to the educational, social and behavioral difficulties they produce.
3. Provide strategies, techniques and resources to support students with AS in educational and social success.
